3. For entries under Column 12 of the Schedule attached to the Employees' Provident Fund Organisation, Lower Division Clerks, Recruitment Rules 1992, the following shall be substituted:

"5% by selection amongst the Group 'D' staff who possess matriculation or equivalent qualification and have rendered 5 years regular service in Group 'D' on the basis of Departmental qualifying examination and 5% of the vacancies shall be filled by promotion on seniority-cum-fitness basis from Group 'D' employees who possess matriculation or equivalent qualification and have completed minimum 5 years of regular service in Group 'D'."

Provided that no employee appointed through the Departmental qualifying examination or by promotion shall either be sanctioned increment or confirmed in the grade of Lower Division Clerk until he passes a prescribed typewriting test in English or Hindi at a minimum speed of 30 words per minute in English or 25 words in Hindi per minute.

Provided further that if any or all of the vacancies falling in the Departmental qualifying examination quota of 5% referred to above cannot be filled in an office in a year because of want of sufficient number of successful candidates, such vacancy or vacancies, as the case may be, shall be filled by direct recruitment as in the case of residual 90% vacancies".

MEDICAL COUNCIL OF INDIA

New Delhi, the 17th December 1998

S.O. No. MCI-34(41)98 Med.:—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (fc), section 33 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956), the Medical Council of India with the previous sanction of the Central Government hereby makes the following regulations to amend the Medical Council of India (Criteria for identification of students admitted in excess of admission capacity of medical college) Regulations, 1997.

1. (1) These regulations may be called the Medical Council of India (Criteria for identification of students admitted in excess of admission capacity of medical college) (Amendment) Regulations, 1998.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2. In the Medical Council of India (Criteria for identification of students admitted in excess of admission capacity of medical college) Regulations, 1997, in regulations 9 for the words, "shall be referred to the Central Government whose decision shall be final", the words "shall be referred to the Central Government for decision" shall be substituted.

PUNJAB WAKF BOARD

Ambala Cantt., the 5th November 1998

No. Wakf 42/(2)/88/Vol. III:—In continuation of the powers delegated to Shri M.K. Khan, Chief Executive Officer, Punjab Wakf Board, Ambala Cantt. w.e.f. 3-10-1998 vide order dated 22-10-1998, I, A.K. Thatai, IRS, Administrator, Punjab Wakf Board, Ambala Cantt. in exercise of the powers conferred under-section 27 of the Wakf Act, 1995, hereby delegate the following additional powers to Shri M.K. Khan, Chief Executive Officer, Punjab Wakf Board w.e.f. 3rd November, 1998:—

1. To sanction leases of agricultural wakf land for lease amount upto Rs. 20,000/- per annum if the lease amount is according to the schedule of rates fixed by the Administrator.
